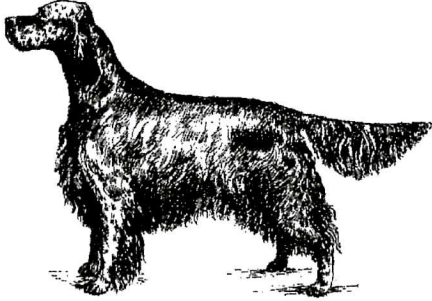


2013 Judging Seminars

MODULE 2 is aimed at potential Judges aspiring to qualify for the joint breed club 'B' List. It is designed to give participants a better understanding of the breed and basic requirements of judging, allowing them to judge English Setters more competently and confidently. The day is focussed around a series of Practical Presentations, Hands-on Judging Experience, Written Questionnaire, Discussions on various aspects of the breed and Judges role.

MODULE 3 is aimed at potential Judges aspiring to qualify for the joint breed club 'A3' List. It is breed specific seminar designed to assess each candidates understanding of the breed and their skills to judge English Setters at Ch. Show level prior to being asked to award CC's in English Setters for the first time. The seminar is focussed around individual assessment and not training and will be run in accordance with The Kennel Club's "Code of Best Practice for the Running of a Breed Seminar and Judging Competence Assessment".
